Beethoven – Symphony No. 9: Mvt. III mm. 99-115 (**10-12**)

Brahms – Symphony No. 1: Mvt. I opening - **B**

Mozart – Symphony No. 39: Mvt. I opening - 23 after **D**

Prokofiev – Symphony No. 1: Mvt. I opening - **12** (or **H**); Mvt. II opening - **C** (m.20 or **3**)

Schumann – Symphony No. 2: Mvt. II: Scherzo (first page)

Strauss – *Don Juan*: first page

- 3.** Possible sight-reading or additional excerpts from the standard repertoire
